

Pre-Paid Funerals



The Ivan Butler Pre–Paid Funeral Plan, allows you to plan for your funeral, according to your wishes, and protect your family of any unnecessary confusion and financial burden regarding funeral arrangements.

Decisions can be made logically and less emotionally about financial expenses, rather than after the fact. Under the Pre-Paid Funerals Code of Practice Regulations 1996, all Pre-Paid monies are required to be held in a trust by a Pre-Paid Funeral manager. A numbered Pre–Paid Funeral Contract is prepared, detailing your pre-paid funeral arrangements, to facilitate provision for the contracted service.

The decision to Pre–Pay is of course yours, and you are under no obligation to do so. However, if you are considering it, you may consider completing our booklet 'My Personal Wishes', as an appropriate alternative to a will.

Your requirements are detailed in the same manner, but without the financial commitment.
