### **Warning Signs**

Simple things we take for granted may well be serious warning signs. Extreme weather conditions are a red flag for owners with large trees on their property. The bigger the tree, the greater the risk of hazard especially after a windy storm or heavy rainfall.

Watch out for these warning signs that may indicate it's time to take action.

- Dead branches in the crown
- Excessive or sudden loss of leaves
- Unusual leaning of the tree
- Rotting areas or patches on the trunk
- Bald spots on the bark
- Fungi at the base of the tree
