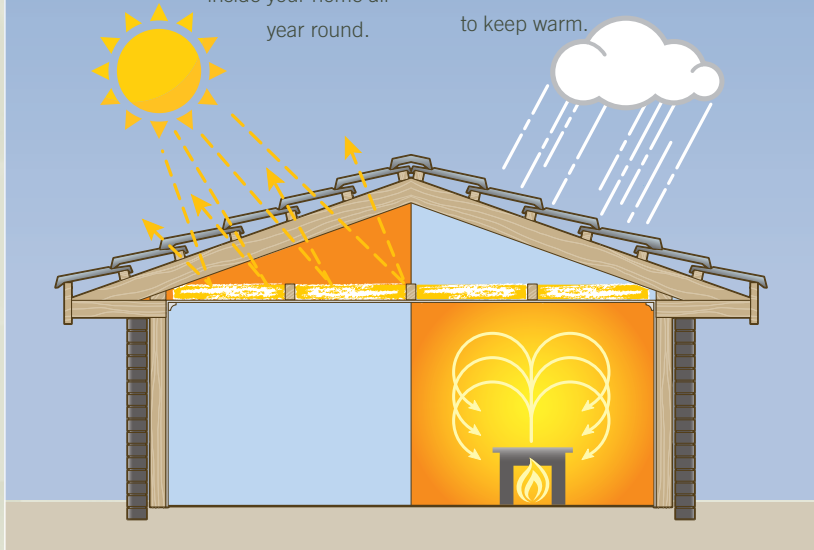

- The millions of tiny air cells in Bradford Gold Insulation slow the transfer of heat through your ceiling and helps regulate the temperature inside your home all year round.
- Without insulation, even the best designed and constructed home will allow heat to pass through external surfaces - as much as 42% of a home's heat can transfer through the ceiling alone.
- This means that in summer, your home will get hot faster and in winter it will be harder to keep warm.

The CSIRO helped to develop AccuRate software which is used to rate the energy efficiency of residential dwellings. The software recognises insulation and ventilation as factors in reducing household heating and cooling energy loads.

Results for a brick veneer, concrete slab, tiled roof house, with Building Code of Australia (BCA) 2006 energy efficiency provisions 'deemed to comply' levels of ceiling insulation, show that additional savings of around 4% - 5% can be achieved by including roof ventilation. This translates into substantial savings, year after year.

Bulk insulation in your ceiling is a cost efficient means of achieving a more consistent temperature inside your home. By lowering the reliance on heating and cooling appliances, substantial savings in your home's energy costs can be achieved. ROOF SARKING

Roof Sarking under tiles provides a reflective barrier which reduces the amount of heat transfer into and out of your home. It also acts as a weatherproof barrier to stop moisture entering your home in extreme weather conditions. Bristle Roofing recommends the installation of sarking (an impermeable reflective foil sarking) regardless of roof pitch or the location of your home.



ENERGY EFFICIENCY

All new homes in Australia are now required to meet minimum standards of energy efficiency. Installing sarking in your ceiling space will help minimise the loss of precious heat during the winter, keep your home cool during the summer and help reduce your energy use. When installed under roof tiles, sarking will reflect up to 95% of radiant heat away from the roof space and can add up to R1.3 to the thermal resistance of the roof system.

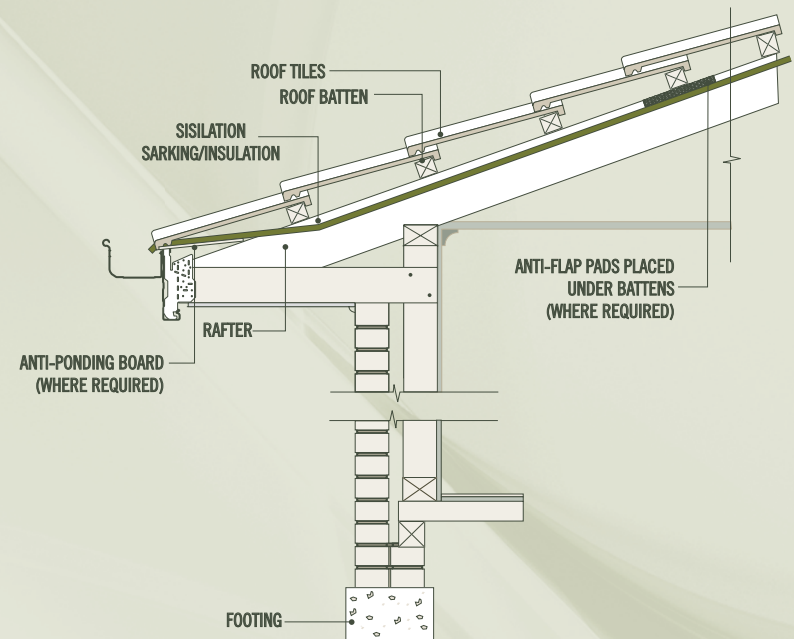
PROTECTING YOUR HOME

Including sarking in your roof offers a number of key benefits:

- **Dust barrier** – In an unsarked roof, airborne dust can enter and collect in the ceiling space, bringing potentially harmful contaminants into your home. Sarking will significantly reduce the build up of dust in your roof space, giving you a more comfortable living environment.
- **Bushfire protection** – Sarking is mandatory in bushfire prone areas. Sarking helps protect your home from flying embers entering the ceiling space through the roof in the event of a bushfire.
- **Storm protection** – In extreme weather conditions, hail or flying debris can damage the roof. Sarking can assist channel moisture away into the gutters and protecting the interior of your home from potential water damage.

BENEFITS OF SARKING

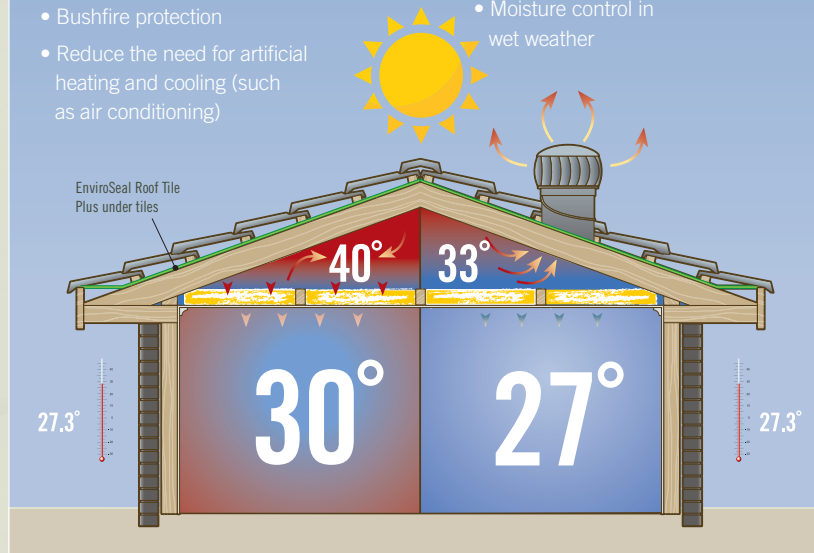
- Weather protection

VENTILATION

Heat is extracted from the roof cavity through ventilation systems.

BENEFITS OF VENTILATION

- Reduced roof space temperature
- More pleasant living space temperature
- Moisture control in wet weather



ROOF VENTILATION

When you consider that in summer, the heat inside your roof can reach over 70°C you can understand the tough job that insulation and ventilation have to do. Ventilation reduces the buildup of heat in your roof space and allows your insulation to work far more effectively.

10% COOLER

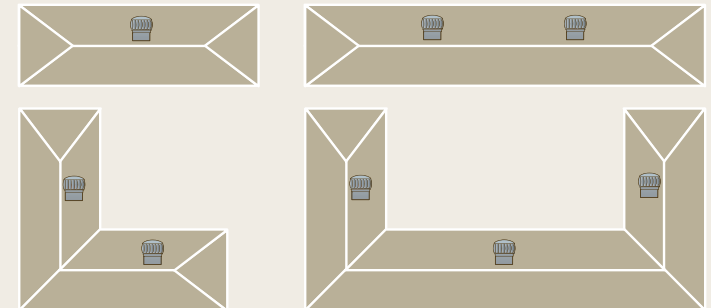
In a controlled test in an uninsulated, Sydney suburban home during summer, the roofspace temperature was 17.5% hotter without ventilation. But importantly, the inside of the home was 10% cooler with ventilation.

Note: Tests were carried out by Edmonds in the hallway of a sample house in Hornsby during summer - 4 bedroom, 2 storey, brick veneer, tiled, sarked roof, separate lounge and dining, double garage, approximately 35 squares.

HOW DOES VENTILATION WORK?

Ventilation works actively to reduce temperature build up by replacing trapped hot air with cooler, ambient air from outside. A wind powered ventilator works through the exhaust forces created by the turning turbine.

RECOMMENDED VENTILATION LEVELS

If your roof is a regular shape, one vent is sufficient for around 10 squares (90m²) of roof surface.
