



9 TIPS

Maintaining your Stone Bathrooms

- Have the stone surfaces professionally cleaned and sealed.
- Use only PH neutral cleaners designed for stone in your showers. This will prevent you from damaging the stone surface.
- Have good fall going towards the drain. This will help reduce mould as the shower can dry out.
- Have silicon placed in the corners to avoid water getting under the tiles. This should be replaced every 2 years as it loses its elasticity and cracks.
- **5** Remove mould with specially designed cleaners for stone.
- 6 Clean grout with strong detergents designed for stone.
- Clean showers weekly to avoid soap scum building up with our 'Stone Deep Clean' Detergent.
- 8 Mop up spills as soon as possible.
- Avoid placing any acidic or alkaline products directly onto the surface of the stone.
- DO NOT use products like 'Exit Mould', 'Domestos', 'Shower Power', 'Easy-Off Bam' or any other strong acid cleaner in your shower as this will dull the polish on the marble surface. We recommend our 'Stone Deep Clean' to clean your marble showers and glass shower screens.
- DO NOT use harsh scourers or course abrasive creams on stone surfaces as they will remove the gloss.
- Clean showers every 1-2 weeks to keep it looking clean and in good condition.
- Keep metal object off the surface as they may rust due to the moist air inside the bathroom.
