



DRESS CODE - Golf Course, Putting Green or Range

NOT ACCEPTABLE

- Metal Spikes in shoes
- All denim fabrics and colours
- All jean and jean style trousers, shorts and shirts
- TAB / Stubbies, yakka work style shorts, both tailored or elastic waisted
- All cotton stretch synthetic elastic waisted board shorts and casual leisure shorts
- Track suit pants, gym shorts and bike pants
- Shirts without a collar
- Shirts with large advertising symbols and motifs
- Unbelted shorts / trousers
- **LADIES** – All of the above and no shorts or skirts shorter than 7 inches above the knee when kneeling

ACCEPTABLE

- Golf Shoes with soft spikes or flat soled fully covered sport shoes.
- Dress walk shorts – tailored style with belt
- Tailored trousers with belt
- Short or long socks (not short business socks)
- Shirts with collars. Must be tucked in at **ALL** times

Care for the Course

All players are expected to assist in the general care of the course.

In order to maintain the course & be considerate to fellow golfers, please observe the following:

- Please rake all sand bunkers used
- Please use a pitch repairer on all greens
- There are sand buckets provided around the course. Please use this sand to repair all tee & fairway divots.

Motorised carts are not permitted in the Car Park. Please use bag drop off. Carts are to obey the 90 degree rule except where directed otherwise and remain at least 15m from greens or tees. Carts must remain on the path around tees and greens.
