At ElecPlumb we will:

- Comply with all relevant laws, external processes and our own safety policies at all times.
- Provide relevant information, training, instruction and supervision when required.
- Effectively consult, co-ordinate, and co-operate to create a safe working environment.
- Provide resources and apply risk management processes with an emphasis on elimination control.
- Be proactive to the identification and management of risks on site.
- Thoroughly report and investigate any incident and implement any corrective actions. If necessary, remove all persons from any unsafe environment and/or cease activities if unsafe conditions are identified.
- Support any injured team member in their rehabilitation and return to work.
- Attend and participate in any relevant safety training.
- Regular reviews of our safety and work practices with the intent of continuous improvement.

At ElecPlumb we work with the strongest of views that there will never be an acceptable reason to not comply with work safety and legal obligations or the health and safety standards outlined above.
