



Quattro Grain Terminal (Berth 103)

The project is the construction of the Quattro Grain Terminal (Berth 103) and LandTeam has been involved with Kerman since the earliest design phases of the Quattro project.

The export terminal development is under construction with anticipated completion being November, 2015. The export terminal will comprise a road receiving hopper, a rail receiving facility, an elevated over-and-underloading conveyor system, eight flat bottom and nine small cone bottom silos for grain storage and associated structures.
