### IMPORTANT INFORMATION (Please Read)

#### Batteries

Batteries supplied by The Battery Terminal hold a manufacturer's warranty of 12 or 24 months, see front of invoice for details. Warranty will be void if the battery is left sit (not used) for longer than four weeks. Warranty will be void if any external damage is visible to the battery, battery terminals or surrounding area. Also if the vehicle that the battery has been installed in is not driven regularly or charged with the correct charger. Warranty will be void if the battery fails due to poor installation by an unauthorised person. For full warranty to be given vehicle and battery must be inspected. Original invoice required.

#### Correct Operation of Your Air Conditioning System

Correct operating instructions for your Air Conditioning System, to ensure optimum usage. Begin with both front windows down and start air con on outside air to blow the residual hot air from the vehicles cabin. Windows up, then return the air con to recycle & face. Fan speed medium.

#### Air Conditioning System

The air conditioning system in your vehicle requires servicing every 2 years for optimum results. This service includes removing old gas, oil, o rings, receiver drier and relays, if necessary cabin filter also. All moisture is removed from the air conditioning system. The presence of moisture in the air conditioning system can cause corrosion within the internal working parts and corrosion can result in the system failing and damaging the system. This is not included in your standard mechanical servicing.

#### Installing New Air Conditioning Compressor

Prior to installing any new compressor, you must identify the root cause of failure with the original compressor. Any other defective A/C components must be replaced to prevent damage to the new compressor. RECOMMENDED: The receiver drier, Condenser, TX Valve, Oil and the A/C System is flushed using an approved flushing agent.

#### Parts

Parts supplied by The Battery Terminal are covered under varying manufacturer's warranty. Please discuss at time of appointment.

#### Air Conditioning Re-Gas

Your vehicles air conditioning system has been filled with air conditioning refrigerant injected with UV dye and ran under workshop conditions. There is no guarantee's of how long the refrigerant will last. This is the first stage of the diagnostic process for your vehicles air conditioning system. This process may lead to your vehicle being diagnosed with a further problem. If your vehicle is presented at our workshop with insufficient refrigerant to run the air conditioning system correctly under 1 calendar month, on completion of the vehicles air conditioning work carried out the gassing of the vehicle will be provided free of charge. All other costs relating to the further work needed will be calculated and charged to the customer.
