Avoid any Anti Bacterial, Bleach or Amonia based products.

Toilet Tissue

Check on packaging that tissue is recommended for septic tank use.

Floor Cleaner

Use hot water and detergents – you can add natural bacterial cleaners such as Vinegar, Bicarbonate of Soda or Tee-Tree Oil to your hot water. When finished it is recommended to dispose of water to lawn or garden rather than flushing down sink.

All treatment systems rely on bacterial decomposition to help reduce the solids within the system, it is advised to restrict the use of harsh chemicals or bleaches, as these can kill the micro-organisms and reduce the effectiveness of the system. Strictly avoid all caustic products such as drain and oven cleaners, such products are extremely toxic to your system therefore causing offensive odours if used.
