

Retaining walls can be used to reclaim land that is unusable due to it's gradient, to retain areas of cut and fill or to create raised garden beds.

Retaining walls can be constructed from many different materials including Timber sleepers, Coppers logs, Sandstone, Bricks, Besser blocks and Bolder stone.

The type of materials used and the wall construction method will depend on the wall height and amount of fill retained, the ground on which it is built, whether it is hidden or highly visible as well as personal choice.

Stairs can look great and are of course very practical when incorporated into a retaining wall.
