WHAT CAN A HOME OWNER DO TO PREVENT TERMITES?

Termites live every where in the ground so the most affective way of preventing termites from attacking is to apply a chemical termite barrier around your home.

Termites love moisture and wood, they need it to survive.

So to help control them there are some easy things you can do!

- Make sure the chemical termite barrier is not physically disturbed by gardening
- Advise your pest control company if you have installed paving or mulch, or new plumbing since the termite barrier was applied
- Prevent moisture build up around the home
- Divert water away from the home by using proper guttering, splash blocks and down pipes
- Make sure there is proper ventilation beneath any wooden floors
- Remove any off cuts, debris or any untreated timbers
- Remove any old tree stumps or roots near the building
- Make sure trees and shrubs are trimmed so they aren't covering any vents
