

# How the demolition process works

Townsville Demolitions aims to make the demolition process as easy, convenient and stress-free as possible for you. Here is a clear run-down of what to expect from the process:

## Step 1: Free Inspection

A thorough inspection of the building or home is performed. This includes an assessment of the materials involved, a safety check for asbestos and a general feasibility study for the demolition.

## Step 2: Quote

You will receive a quote for the full demolition service.

## Step 3: Apply for Demolition Permits

If you accept the quote and wish to proceed, we apply for the demolition permit – this needs to be certified by the local council before we can begin the project. We also ensure we have all necessary work method statements prepared.

## Step 4: Disconnect Utility Services

This involves disconnecting utilities on the site, such as water, and sewerage. If you would prefer to do this yourself, that's fine, otherwise we will include it in the quote and take care of this for you.

## Step 5: Perform the Demolition

Once the demolition permit is approved, we perform the demolition.

## Step 6: Clear Site

Upon completion of the demolition, we clear the site.
