

## What Can and Can't Go In A Skip Bin

The identification of your waste type is normally fairly straight forward, however it is important because certain waste types are prohibited from being placed in skips and also in many cases, the waste type affects the price of the Skip Bin Services.

It is important to correctly specify your intended waste type because placement of other waste types may result in additional disposal charges after the skip is collected. The Table Below provides some guidelines. If you have any doubt as to which waste type your waste belongs, please feel free to call Luckys Scrap Metals and our experiences staff will happily assist you.

**NOTE:** When selecting a waste type you must ensure that no other types of waste are placed in the skip. If this occurs, you will be liable to pay for the disposal cost of disposal as per the correct waste type. Please refer to Luckys Scrap metals Skip Bin Services Terms and Conditions for Additional information.

The inclusion of any material containing asbestos, any form of insulation material, or any other dangerous material is strictly prohibited.

Waste Type	What you can put in	What you can't put in
<b>General Waste</b>	Household waste (odds and end, appliances, furniture, rubbish, garden waste), office waste, light construction waste (wood, gyprock, metal)	Liquids, tyres, batteries, food waste, concrete, bricks, tiles, soil, sand, clay, rocks and turf
<b>Green Waste</b>	Garden waste only. Branches, leaves, grass and clippings	Tree trunks over 20cm in diameter or stumps over 30cm in diameter.
<b>Concrete/Bricks</b>	Concrete and bricks	Any other materials
<b>Heavy Waste</b>	Concrete, bricks, soil, rock, tiles, pavers and can also include general waste and green waste	Liquids, tyres, batteries, food waste
<b>Mixed Recyclables</b>	This consists of recyclables plastics, cardboard, glass and metal. All other wastes (eg green waste, asbestos) are specifically excluded.	Any other materials
<b>Soil or Dirt</b>	Clean soil or sand	Any other materials. Must not be contaminated with bricks, tiles etc or any other man-made waste types
<b>Hardfill/Rubble</b>	Bricks, Tiles, Concrete, Pavers, Soil and Sand	Any other materials
<b>Concrete (Pure)</b>	Concrete	Any other material at all
<b>Bricks</b>	Bricks	Any other material at all

### ITEMS NEVER TO BE PLACED IN A SKIP BIN OF ANY KIND

- Putrescible waste (food waste etc), asbestos, hazardous waste, insulation material of any kind, liquids (paints, oils, chemicals) (Dry paints in cans are OK), gas bottles, empty chemical containers, tree trunks.
- Items priced individually from your local waste centre include but no limited to Mattresses and tyres.
