"The new tilt tray that has an 8.5 metre tray will be a welcome addition to our fleet," explains Clinton Hodge of Swan Towing. "We have an extensive customer base with more and more clients requesting movements of items in the 5-7 tonne range and with

this new truck, we can easily do that.

"It will also be especially valuable to use for the movements of medium sized busses as they seem to be making them increasingly longer. With the length on the new tray, this won't be an issue."

Specialising in heavy recovery

The new heavy recovery under lift is currently having the finishing touches made to it. It has once again been built by Ekebol Engineering in Queensland - the only Australian company to build this type of lifting equipment specifically for Australian conditions.

This will be the fifth under lift on the Swan Towing fleet. Keeping with tradition, the under lift unit will once again be fitted onto a Kenworth T604.

"With more units in operation, we can better service our customers and offer quicker response times," says Clinton.

"We seem to be getting more and more calls from companies that have been unhappy with their previous recovery arrangements so it became obvious that we needed to order another unit to keep up with the demand.

"With the new unit, we will have four dedicated heavy recovery units and one medium recovery unit for the smaller 6-8 tonners, so we should be able to keep all our customers happy as well as the new clients that call us."
