Wall screens will significantly reduce the minimum required safety distances by protecting the wall from the hottest parts of the fire. Available in our full colour range, they offer a stylish and practical solution compared to an industry-standard flue shield.

Custom: We can accommodate most sizes. All custom wall screens will incur additional charges.

- Pyroclassic Fires can be installed with a double skin half round flue shield, or for minimum clearances from combustible walls a correctly sized wall screen must be installed.
- Alternatively you can install a Pyroclassic Fire without wall screens if you choose to use a non-combustible wall board and install it as per the manufacture specifications. Usually this involves ensuring a 25mm ventilated air gap is maintained between the wall board and any timber framing, through the bottom, up between the combustible surface and the screening material and out of the top similar to our wall screens.
- In some instances the wall may not contain any combustible material and therefore will not require any screening.
- Pyroclassic wall screens now have an easy to install hanging system which requires just 2 fixing holes per screen.

Pyroclassic's ceramic chamber, the Heat Sustainer, stores more heat than any other conventional wood fire providing a slow and even release of its heat over an extended period.

HOW A PYROCLASSIC WORKS

THE SCIENCE

The steel in a conventional steel firebox absorbs heat rapidly but this also means that it releases that heat rapidly too. By comparison, ceramic absorbs and releases heat at a more moderated rate.


Weighing in at a whopping 45 kilograms, the Heat Sustainer is a formidable ceramic thermal mass that can absorb and store an abundance of heat that is slowly and evenly released over several hours.



If the insulating hearth is installed flush with the surrounding combustible floor, there must be a minimum distance of 370mm from the front of the fire to the front edge on the hearth. The minimum width of the insulating hearth must not be less than 680mm with the fire centred from each side of the hearth. If the hearth is raised, the floor protector area at the front can be reduced as per the 'E' Measurement Calculator, for example; the large Pyroclassic Raised Hearth & Woodbin is 250mm high, allowing for a reduction in the distance between the edge of the floor protector and the front of the fire from 370mm to 300mm.

As an alternative to our health and wood bin options, you can use a minimum of a 20mm+ thick non-combustible insulated board with a non-combustible top or 50mm+ thick masonry slab.

The small raised Woodbin options require a minimum of a 4mm thick layer of non-combustible material installed underneath to meet all the necessary clearances and the correct 'E' measurement.
